WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 813-G, filed August 12, 1976, having requested Commission approval under the provisions of Decision No. 85189, to supply natural gas in excess of 50 Mcf per day to Pengo Corporation (Applicant), and

WHEREAS: Applicant will use this gas to operate a steel forging and heat treating plant at a new location, having consolidated his operations from two locations to one new one, and

WHEREAS: Applicant was a firm customer at the old location, and

WHEREAS: The consolidation will amount to a reduction in total gas consumption; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under provisions of Decision No. 85189 for Pacific Gas and Electric Company to supply the requested gas service to Pengo Corporation, effective September 14, 1976.
