**SUBJECT:** Request to Provide Additional Natural Gas Service by  
Pacific Gas & Electric Company

**WHEREAS:** PACIFIC GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 818-G, filed August 23, 1976, having requested Commission approval under the provisions of Decision No. 85189, to supply additional natural gas in excess of 50 Mcf per day to Sebastopol Co-op Cannery (Applicant), and

**WHEREAS:** Applicant's request is for an additional average daily consumption of 25 Mcf, raising his existing average daily consumption from 200 Mcf to 225 Mcf, and

**WHEREAS:** Applicant will use this additional gas to operate a direct-fired, continuous belt, apple dryer, and

**WHEREAS:** Fuel oil cannot be used in this process without damage to the product; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under provisions of Decision No. 85189 for PG&E to supply the requested service to Sebastopol Co-op Cannery, effective September 21, 1976.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above advice letter and application be marked to show that they were authorized under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1956. The effective date of this Resolution is the date hereof.
