SUBJECT: Request to Provide Additional Natural Gas Service by
Southern California Gas Company

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 1011, filed August 23, 1976, having requested Commission approval under the provisions of Decision No. 85189, to supply additional natural gas in excess of 50 Mcf per day to Redlands Laundry & Linen Service (Applicant), and

WHEREAS: Applicant will use this gas to operate two new gas-fired laundry dryers, and

WHEREAS: Although Applicant claims this new equipment will only serve to reduce the hours of operation and will not increase the existing level of gas service, the addition of the new equipment provides for a potential increase in the level of average service demand from 75 Mcfd to 91 Mcfd, and

WHEREAS: Fuel oil cannot be used in this equipment; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under provisions of Decision No. 85189 for Southern California Gas Company to supply the requested service to Redlands Laundry & Linen Service, effective September 22, 1976.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above advice letter and application be marked to show that they were authorized under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1958. The effective date of this Resolution is the date hereof.
