SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Establishment of Balancing Accounts

WHEREAS: CALIFORNIA-PACIFIC UTILITIES COMPANY, by letter dated September 3, 1976, requests authority to establish and maintain Balancing Accounts, and

WHEREAS: The purpose of the Balancing Accounts would be to accrue increases and/or decreases in the cost of purchased gas until Commission action can authorize rate revisions, and

WHEREAS: The utility has recently been faced with several purchased gas increases with the anticipation of others to come in the near future, and

WHEREAS: The 30-day notification period in the utility's filed PGA clause and the press of Commission business have made it extremely difficult for the utility to track all of the recent rate revisions on a timely basis as they occur, and

WHEREAS: Separate Balancing Accounts will be maintained for the utility's South Tahoe and Needles rate areas, and

WHEREAS: The Commission has previously authorized similar Balancing Accounts for So. Cal. and PG&E, and

WHEREAS: We find that the establishment and maintenance of such Balancing Accounts would be in the best interest of all concerned and would result in a reduction in the number of rate changes that have be be made; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that California-Pacific Utilities Company be granted authority under Sections 454, 491 and 701 of the Public Utilities Code to establish and maintain a Balancing Account for both its South Tahoe and Needles rate areas for the purpose of accuring over and under collections caused by purchased gas revisions.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Balancing Accounts shall be maintained until such time as a Purchased Gas Adjustment with deferred accounting be finalized by the Commission and that the utility be notified that amortization of over and under collections, as well as PGA rate revisions may not occur without further order from the Commission. The effective date of this Resolution is the date hereof.
