SUBJECT: Order Authorizing PGA Rate Increase

WHEREAS: SOUTHWEST GAS CORPORATION, by Advice Letter No. 173, filed November 8, 1976, having requested authority under the PGA clauses of the utility's filed tariffs, to file revised tariff sheets applicable to its Placer County rate area in order to track rate increases by its supplier, Northwest Pipeline Corp., as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 1366-G to 1373-G, inclusive, and

WHEREAS: The proposed revenue revision of \$57,210 will offset the proposed rate increases by Northwest Pipeline Corp., and

WHEREAS: This filing is made pursuant to the PGA clause of the utility's filed tariff schedules, except for the short notice authorization, and

WHEREAS: In the event that the FPC should approve rate schedules different from that requested by Northwest or require a different effective date, SoWest will file substitute tariff sheets to reflect approved rate levels, and

WHEREAS: We find this rate increase to be reasonable; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Southwest Gas Corp. be granted authority under Sections 454, 491 and 701 of the Public Utilities Code and under the provisions of the PGA clause of its filed tariff schedule to place the above tariff sheets or subsequent substitute tariff sheets into effect on December 1, 1976 or on a date concurrent with the effective date of Northwest's FPC approved rate increase, whichever date is later.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above tariff sheets and/or any subsequent substitute tariff sheets be marked to show that they were issued under Resolution of the State of California No. G-1976. The effective date of this Resolution is the date hereof.
