SUBJECT: Request to Provide Natural Gas Service by Pacific Gas and Electric Company

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY by Advice Letter 831-G, filed October 19, 1976, having requested Commission approval under the provisions of Decision No. 85189, to supply temporary, emergency natural gas service in excess of 50 Mcf per day to Edwards Packing Company (Applicant), and

WHEREAS: Applicant's request is for 86 Mcfd on a temporary, emergency basis, and

WHEREAS: Applicant will use this gas to operate four direct-fired tunnel dryers to dry raisins, and

WHEREAS: Fuel oil cannot be used in this process without damage to the product; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 491 of the Public Utilities Code and under provisions of Decision No. 85189 for Pacific Gas and Electric Company to supply the requested temporary, emergency service to Edwards Packing Company, effective October 20, 1976 and terminating December 15, 1976.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above letter be marked to show that it was authorized under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1983. The effective date of this Resolution is the date hereof.
