SUBJECT: Order Revising Prior Commission Resolution

WHEREAS: GARBERVILLE GAS CORPORATION, by Advice Letter No. 32, filed November 8, 1976, having requested authority to reduce its lifeline quantities from 25 therms per month to 15 therms per month during the period May through October, and from 85 therms per month to 40 therms per month during the period November through April, and

WHEREAS: Lifeline quantities for all LPG companies under Commission jurisdiction were established by Commission Resolution No. G-1876, dated April 27, 1976, and

WHEREAS: A review of the residential sales of Garberville Gas Corporation reveals that the lifeline quantities established for that utility by Resolution No. G-1876 are in excess of the system average sales of 17.2 therms per summer month and 43.2 therms per winter month, and

WHEREAS: The lower usage is attributable to smaller homes and a geographical lifestyle considerably different from statewide average, and

WHEREAS: The utility will file new lifeline rate structures if it can get approval for this amendment, and

WHEREAS: We find this request to be reasonable and that it would be in the best of interest of all concerned to have lifeline rate structures placed into effect as soon as possible; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 491 and 1708 of the Public Utilities Code to amend Commission Resolution No. G-1876 to establish new lifeline quantities for Garberville Gas Corporation in the amounts of 15 therms per month for cooking and water heating and an additional 25 therms per month for space heating during the period November through April. Such revisions to be effective this date.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above advice letter be marked to show that it was approved by Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1986. The effective date of this resolution is the date hereof.
