WHEREAS: These tests require a maximum of 1.4 million cubic feet per day of natural gas and are vital to the interests of the United States; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under provisions of Decision No. 85189 for SoCal to supply the requested service under Priority 2 until March l, 1977 to Atomics International, effective this date.
