SUBJECT: Request to Provide Additional Natural Gas Service  
by Pacific Gas & Electric Company

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 838-G, filed November 18, 1976, having requested Commission approval under the provisions of Decision No. 85189, to supply additional natural gas in excess of 50 Mcf per day to Raymond R. Crane, (Applicant), and

WHEREAS: Applicant's request is for an average daily consumption of 58 Mcf, and

WHEREAS: Applicant will use this additional gas to operate two direct-fired walnut drying tunnels, and

WHEREAS: Fuel oil cannot be used in this process without damage to the product; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under provisions of Decision No. 85189 for PG&E to supply the requested service to Raymond R. Crane, effective December 18, 1976, which constitutes regular statutory notice.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above advice letter and application be marked to show that they were authorized under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1993. The effective date of this Resolution is the date hereof.
