RESOLUTION

SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Increase in Customer Advances for
Gas Main and Gas Service Extensions

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 1030, filed November 15, 1976, requests authority under Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to revise Rule No. 20, Gas Main Extensions, and Rule No. 21, Gas Service Extensions, as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 14695-G to 14700-G, inclusive, and

WHEREAS: One of the revisions requested would amend Rule No. 20 by increasing the advance supplied by customer per foot of gas main extension beyond the allowable free length from \$3.50 to \$3.80 per foot for gas main extensions, and

WHEREAS: A further revision requested would amend Rule No. 21 by increasing the advance supplied by customer per foot of gas service extension beyond the allowable free length from \$2.75 to \$3.15 per foot, and

WHEREAS: The above increases are based on a utility review of current construction costs in conformance with Section E.2. of Rule 20 and Section H.1. of Rule 21 and will make the advance requirements similar to those of other California Utilities, thus improving uniformity, and

WHEREAS: The free footage allowance for swimming pool heaters, gas refrigerators, clothes dryers, air conditioning equipment and garbage incinerators has been eliminated in conformance with existing Commission policy of conservation, and

WHEREAS: No significant additional revenue will be realized by the utility due to these increases because they will merely offset existing construction costs; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Sections 454 and 455 of the Public Utilities Code to make the above sheets effective on December 15, 1976, which constitutes regular statutory notice.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above sheets be marked to show that they were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1995. The effective date of this Resolution is the date hereof.
