R E S O L U T I O N

SUBJECT: Request to Provide Additional Natural Gas Service  
by Pacific Gas and Electric Company

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 843-G, filed December 1, 1976, having requested Commission approval under the provisions of Decision No. 85189, to supply additional natural gas in excess of 50 Mcf per day to Spaich Brothers (Applicant), and

WHEREAS: Applicant's request is for an additional average daily consumption of 150 Mcf, raising the existing average daily consumption from 308 Mcf to 458 Mcf, and

WHEREAS: Applicant will use this additional gas to operate six direct-fired prune drying tunnels, and

WHEREAS: Fuel oil cannot be used in this process without damage to the product; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under provisions of Decision No. 85189 for Pacific Gas and Electric Company to supply the requested service to Spaich Brothers effective December 31, 1976, which constitutes regular statutory notice.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above advice letter and application be marked to show that they were authorized under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1998. The effective date of this Resolution is the date hereof.


