SUBJECT: Order Authorizing A Tracking Rate Increase

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 847-G, filed December 2, 1976, having requested authority under the provisions of Decision No. 86381, in Application No. 56586, to file revised tariff sheets in order to track a rate increase from Canadian sources, as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 10078-G to 10095-G, inclusive, and

WHEREAS: The proposed annual revenue revision of \$57,027,000 will offset the proposed rate increase, and

WHEREAS: In the event that the FPC should require a different effective date, any temporary over collections of PG&E's offsetting increase will be accounted for in accounts established by Commission order pursuant to Section 792.5 of the Public Utilities Code, and

WHEREAS: We find this rate increase to be reasonable; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that PG&E be granted authority under Sections 454 and 701 of the Public Utilities Code and under the provisions of Decision No. 86381, in Application No. 56586, to place the above tariff sheets into effect on January 1, 1977.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above tariff sheets be marked to show that they were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-2008. The effective date of this Resolution is the date hereof.
