SUBJECT: Order Authorizing PGA Rate Increase

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 1035, filed December 3, 1976, having requested authority under the provisions of Decision No. 86595, in Application No. 55345, to file revised tariff sheets in order to reflect the full effect of the Honor Rancho Storage Field in its operating plant as of January 1, 1977, as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 14738-G to 14754-G, inclusive, and

WHEREAS: The proposed annual revenue revision of \$8,522,000 will cover the estimated costs of acquisition and facilities construction at Honor Rancho, and

WHEREAS: In the event that Commission action should require rate schedules different from that requested herewith, SoCal will file substitute tariff sheets to reflect approved rate levels, and

WHEREAS: We find this rate increase to be reasonable; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Southern California Gas Co. be granted authority under Sections 454 and 701 of the Public Utilities Code, and under the provisions of Decision No. 86595, to place the above tariff sheets or subsequent substitute tariff sheets into effect on January 1, 1977.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above tariff sheets and/or any subsequent substitute tariff sheets be marked to show that they were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-2009. The effective date of this Resolution is the date hereof.
