SUBJECT: Order Authorizing PGA Rate Increase

WHEREAS: SAN DIEGO GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 375-G, filed December 10, 1976, having requested authority under the PGA clauses of the utility's filed tariffs, to file revised tariff sheets in order to track rate increases by its supplier, Southern California Gas Co., as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 2307-G to 2331-G, inclusive, and

WHEREAS: The proposed revenue revision of \$256,200 will offset the proposed rate increase by SoCal, and

WHEREAS: An effective date of January 1, 1977 is requested in order to coincide with the anticipated effective date of SoCal's rate increases, and

WHEREAS: This filing is made pursuant to the PGA clause of the utility's filed tariff schedules except for the short notice authorization, and

WHEREAS: This rate increase is spread on a uniform cents per therm basis for all sales, including lifeline, because the utility has already increased the system average rate by more than 25%, and

WHEREAS: In the event that SoCal should file rate schedules different from that requested or use a different effective date, SDG&E will file substitute tariff sheets to reflect approved rate levels, and

WHEREAS: We find this rate increase to be reasonable; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that SDG&E be granted authority under Sections 454, 491 and 701 of the Public Utilities Code, and under the provisions of the PGA clause of its filed tariff schedule to place the above tariff sheets or subsequent substitute tariff sheets into effect on January 1, 1977, or on a date concurrent with the effective date of SoCal's approved rate increase, whichever date is later.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above tariff sheets and/or any subsequent substitute tariff sheets be marked to show that they were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-2010. The effective date of this Resolution is the date hereof.

SUBJECT: Order Authorizing PGA Rate Increase

WHEREAS: SAN DIEGO GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letters Nos. 375-G, filed 12-10-76 and 375-G Supplement, filed 12-30-76 having requested authority under the PGA clauses of the utility's filed tariffs, to file revised tariff sheets in order to track rate increases by its supplier, Southern California Gas Co., as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 2307-G to 2331-G, inclusive, and

WHEREAS: The proposed revenue revision of \$286,700 will offset the proposed rate increases by SoCal and an effective date of January 5, 1977 is requested in order to coincide with the effective date of SoCal's rate increases, and

WHEREAS: This filing is made pursuant to the PGA clause of the utility's filed tariff schedules except for the short notice authorization, and

WHEREAS: The utility proposes to spread this rate increase on a uniform cents per therm basis for all sales, including lifeline, because the utility has already increased the system average rate by more than 25%, and

WHEREAS: In the event that SoCal should file rate schedules different from that requested or use a different effective date, SDG&E will file substitute tariff sheets to reflect approved rate levels, and

WHEREAS: We find the amount of this rate increase to be reasonable, however we are of the opinion that the rate increase should be applied to nonlifeline rates only; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that San Diego Gas & Electric Company be instructed to file a supplemental advice letter, with substitute tariff sheets revising the filing to place the rate increase upon nonlifeline rates only and that upon receipt of said supplemental advice letter and substitute tariff sheets that authority be granted under Sections 454, 491 and 701 of the Public Utilities Code to place the substitute tariff sheets into effect on January 5, 1977, or on a date concurrent with the effective date of SoCal's approved rate increases, whichever date is later.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above substitute tariff sheets be marked to show that they were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-2010. The effective date of this Resolution is the date hereof.
