R E S O L U T I O N

SUBJECT: Order Authorizing PGA Rate Increase

WHEREAS: CALIFORNIA-PACIFIC UTILITIES COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 96-G, filed December 3, 1976, having requested authority under the PGA clauses of the utility's filed tariffs, to file revised tariff sheets applicable to its Needles rate area in order to track rate increases by its supplier, PG&E, as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 498-G to 500-G, inclusive, and

WHEREAS: The proposed annual revenue revision of \$6,261 will offset the proposed rate increase by PG&E, and

WHEREAS: This filing is made pursuant to the PGA clause of the utility's filed tariff schedules, except for the short-notice authorization, and

WHEREAS: In the event that PG&E should file rate schedules different from those presently requested or use a different effective date, California-Pacific will file substitute tariff sheets to reflect approved rate levels, and

WHEREAS: We find this rate increase to be reasonable; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that California-Pacific Utilities Company be granted authority under Sections 454, 491, and 701 of the Public Utilities Code, and under the provisions of the PGA clause of its filed tariff schedule to place the above tariff sheets or subsequent substitute tariff sheets into effect on January 1, 1977 or on a date concurrent with the effective date of PG&E's approved rate increase, whichever date is later.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above tariff sheets and/or any subsequent substitute tariff sheets be marked to show that they were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-2012. The effective date of this Resolution is the date hereof.
