> SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Changes in Gas Tariff Schedules on Less Than Statutory Notice Which Will Result in Increased Charges

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALLFORNIA GAS COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 1036, filed December 3, 1976, having requested Commission authority under Section 454, 491 and 532 of the Public Utilities Code to amend Schedule No. G-60, Wholesale Natural Gas Service and to file the Fourteenth Supplemental Service Agreement between the utility and the City of Long Beach as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 14755-G to 14761-G, inclusive, and

WHEREAS: The revisions would provide for increases in the City's daily contract demand from 72,000 Mcf to 74,000 Mcf and additional peaking demand from 23,000 Mcf to 25,000 Mcf, and

WHEREAS: The City requests these increased quantities in order to meet anticipated requirements on its system, and

WHEREAS: By Resolution No. C-22193, dated November 23, 1976, the City of Long Beach authorized the City Manager to execute this Fourteenth Service Agreement with Southern California Gas Company, and

WHEREAS: The utility and the City are currently in negotiations for a new service agreement which, if approved by the Commission, will supersede and replace the existing agreement, and

WHEREAS: The requested effective date of December 1, 1976 coincides with the anniversary date of the Long Beach Service Agreement, and

WHEREAS: We find these increases to be justified; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Sections 454, 491 and 532 of the Public Utilities Code to make said sheets effective retroactively as of December 1, 1976.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above tariff sheets be marked to show that they were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-2013. The effective date of this resolution is the date hereof.
