SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Tariff Rule Revisions Resulting in More Restrictive Conditions

WHEREAS: SAN DIEGO GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 376-G, filed January 6, 1977, requests authority under Section V.A. of General Order No. 96-A, to revise Rule No. 6, "Establishment and Re-establishment of Credit", as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 2332-E to 2334-G, inclusive, and

WHEREAS: The proposed revision would add a provision to Rule No. 6 which would allow the utility to require a nondomestic customer to make a cash deposit or furnish a guarantor or bond as a condition of continued service when the basis of credit for such customer has materially changed, and

WHEREAS: The utility has lost approximately \$67,000 over the past two years due to business failures, and

WHEREAS: These losses must be borne by all of the utilities' customers, and

WHEREAS: The proposed rule change would relieve the burden on other customers to some extent, and

WHEREAS: We find that the proposed revisions are reasonable; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code and under Sections V.A. and VI of General Order No. 96-A, to make the above tariff sheets effective on February 15, 1977.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above tariff sheets be marked to show that they were accepted for filing under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-2023. The effective date of this Resloution is the date hereof.
