SUBJECT: Request to Provide Natural Gas Service by Pacific Gas & Electric Company

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 853-G, filed January 11, 1977, having requested Commission approval under the provisions of Decision No. 85189, to supply natural gas in excess of 50 Mcfd to Morgan H. Johnson (Applicant), and

WHEREAS: Applicant's request is for an average daily consumption of 1037 Mcf during the months of August through November, and

WHEREAS: Applicant will use this gas to operate 18 direct fired tunnel type fruit dehydrators for the purpose of drying grapes, and

WHEREAS: Fuel oil cannot be used in this process without contamination of the food product, and

WHEREAS: We find that this applicant will be classified as Priority 2A (permanent) under the end-use criteria adopted in Decision No. 85189; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under the provisions of Decision No. 85189 for PG&E to supply the requested service to Morgan H. Johnson effective February 10, 1977, which constitutes regular statutory notice.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above advice letter and application be marked to show that they were authorized under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-2024. The effective date of this Resolution is the date hereof.
