SUBJECT: Request to Provide Additional Natural Gas Service by Pacific Gas & Electric Company

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 858-G, filed January 11, 1977, having requested Commission approval under the provisions of Decision No. 85189, to supply additional natural gas in excess of 50 Mcf per day to C.S. Khera Dehydrator (Applicant), and

WHEREAS: Applicant's request is for an additional peak day consumption of 240 Mcf, raising his existing peak day consumption from 240 Mcf to 480 Mcf, and

WHEREAS: Applicant will use this additional gas to fuel six atmospheric burners in a prune dehydration operation, and

WHEREAS: Fuel oil cannot be used in this process without damage to the product, and

WHEREAS: We find that Applicant will be classified as Priority 2A under the end-use criteria adopted in Decision No. 85189; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under provisions of Decision No. 85189 for PG&E to supply the requested service to C.S. Khera Dehydrator, effective February 10, 1977, which constitutes regular statutory notice.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above advice letter and application be marked to show that they were authorized under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-2029. The effective date of this Resolution is the date hereof.
