RESOLUTION

SUBJECT: Request to Provide Natural Gas Service
In Excess of 50 Mcfd

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 1044, filed January 25, 1977, having requested Commission approval under the provisions of Decision No. 85189, to supply additional natural gas in excess of 50 Mcf per day to Dutch Brothers Nursery (Applicant) with the following provisions:

1. Applicant's request is for an additional peak daily consumption of 37 Mcf, raising his existing peak daily consumption from 32 Mcf to 69 Mcf.
2. Applicant will use this additional gas to operate 13 Flora Guard greenhouse unit heaters which cannot operate using fuel oil.
3. Applicant will convert an existing 80 HP boiler to fuel oil.
4. We find that since usage is less than 100 Mcfd, this Applicant will be classified in Priority 1 under the end use criteria adopted in Decision No. 85189; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Authority be granted under provisions of Decision No. 85189 for Southern California Gas Company to supply the requested service to Dutch Brothers Nursery effective February 24, 1977, which constitutes regular statutory notice.
2. The above advice letter and application be marked to show that they were authorized under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-2032. The effective date of this Resolution is the date hereof.
