SUBJECT: Request to Provide Natural Gas Service  
In Excess of 50 Mcfd

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 873-G, filed January 28, 1977, having requested Commission approval under the provisions of Decision No. 85189, to supply natural gas in excess of 50 Mcf per day to Montgomery Farms (Applicant), in Merced, Merced County, with the following provisions:

1. Applicant's request is for an average daily consumption of 100 Mcf.
2. Applicant will use this additional gas to operate three direct fired fig dryers.
3. Fuel oil cannot be used in this process without damage to the product.
4. This Applicant will be classified in Priority 1 under the end use criteria adopted in Decision No. 85189; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Authority be granted under provisions of Decision No. 85189 for PG&E to supply the requested service to Montgomery Farms effective this date.
2. The above advice letter and application be marked to show that they were authorized under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-2042. The effective date of this resolution is the date hereof.
