SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Revisions in Rules 20 and 21, Resulting in a Decrease in the Free Footage Allowance

WHEREAS: SAN DIEGO GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 378-G, filed January 27, 1977, requests authority under Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to file revisions in Rules 20 and 21 for the purpose of deleting the free footage allowances for refrigerators, clothes dryers, air conditioning equipment, and garbage incinerators and results in the following:

1. This filing shall not cause any conflict with other schedules or rules nor cause the withdrawal of service.
2. This filing will not increase any rates or charges except for those charges for excess gas main and service pipe extensions that may increase due to the proposed changes.
3. This filing is made to promote conservation of natural gas and to give incentives for lifeline usage.
4. Such reduction in the free footage allowances are hereby found to be just and reasonable, therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Authority be granted under Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code for SDG&E to reduce the free footage allowance for gas main and service extensions.
2. The above tariff sheets be marked to show that they were authorized under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-2046. The effective date of this Resolution is the date hereof.
