RESOLUTION

SUBJECT: Request to Provide Additional Natural Gas Service  
In Excess of 50 Mcfd

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 1045, filed February 3, 1977, having requested Commission approval under the provisions of Decision No. 85189, to supply additional natural gas in excess of 50 Mcf per day to California Custom Shapes Company (Applicant), in Garden Grove, Orange County, with the following provisions:

1. Applicant's request is for an additional average daily consumption of 43 Mcf, raising his existing average daily consumption from 37 Mcf to 80 Mcf.
2. Applicant will use this additional gas in two billet furnaces and two aging ovens in his aluminum foundry.
3. Fuel oil cannot be used in this process without metallurgical damage to the product.
4. This Applicant will be classified in Priority 1 under the end use criteria adopted in Decision No. 85189; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Authority be granted under provisions of Decision No. 85189 for Southern California Gas Company to supply the requested service to California Custom Shapes Company effective March 6, 1977, which constitutes regular statutory notice.
2. The above advice letter and application be marked to show that they were authorized under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-2047. The effective date of this Resolution is the date hereof.
