SUBJECT: Order Authorizing The Temporary Reclassification of Priority of a Nondomestic Customer

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 1046, filed February 4, 1977, having requested Commission approval under the provisions of Decision No. 85189, to reclassify Anchor Hocking Corporation (Applicant), in Los Angeles, from Priority 3 to Priority 2A (temporary) until July 1, 1977, with the following provisions:

1. Applicant's one operating glass furnace was classified as Priority 2B (temporary) until December 2, 1976 at which time it was automatically reclassified as Priority 3.

2. This furnace is over due for a major overhaul and if fired on oil at this time, it would result in a significant increase in the probability of a collapse of essential portions of the furnace, thereby closing the plant and idling about 200 people.

3. Applicant will have another furnace ready for oil firing in June, 1977 at which time the gas operating furnace will be shut down, overhauled and converted.

4. It is reasonable to extend the conversion deadline for this furance; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Southern California Gas Company be granted authority under Section 491 of the Public Utilities Code and under the provisions of Decision No. 85189 to temporarily reclassify Anchor Hocking Corporation as Priority 2A (temporary) under the end use criteria adopted in Decision No. 85189 until July 1, 1977 effective this date.

2. The above advice letter shall be marked to show that it was authorized under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-2048. The effective date of this Resolution is the date hereof.
