RESOLUTION

SUBJECT: Request to Provide Additional Natural Gas Service
in Excess of 50 Mcfd

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 877-G, filed February 7, 1977, having requested Commission approval under the provisions of Decision No. 85189, to supply natural gas in excess of 50 Mcf per day to Elk Grove Unified School District (Applicant), in Sacramento, Sacramento County with the following provisions:

1. Applicant's average daily consumption will be 35 Mcf, but his peak day consumption will be 70 Mcf.
2. About half of the gas will be used for space heating and about half for classroom equipment and domestic type hot water heaters.
3. None of the above equipment, except space heaters, are available with fuel oil firing capabilities.
4. If the peak day space heating load was taken by itself, Commission approval would not be required (under Decision No. 85189) for the utility company to serve the customer, but since the total peak day load (classroom equipment and space heating) exceeds 50 Mcf, Commission approval is necessary.
5. This applicant will be classified as Priority 1 under the end use criteria adopted in Decision No. 85189; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Authority be granted under provisions of Decision No. 85189 for Pacific Gas and Electric Company to supply the requested service to Elk Grove Unified School District effective March 9, 1977, which constitutes regular statutory notice.
2. The above advice letter and application be marked to show that they were authorized under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-2049. The effective date of this Resolution is the date hereof.
