SUBJECT: Request to Provide Natural Gas Service In Excess of 50 Mcfd

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 879-G, filed February 16, 1977, having requested Commission approval under the provisions of Decision No. 85189, to supply natural gas in excess of 50 Mcfd to Favero Ranch (Applicant) in Yuba City, Sutter County with the following provisions:

1. Applicant's request is for average daily consumption of 180 Mcf.
2. Applicant will use this gas to operate four atmospheric burners in direct-fired prune dryers.
3. Fuel oil cannot be used in this process without contamination of the product.
4. We find that this Applicant will be classified in Priority 2A under the end use criteria adopted in Decision No. 85189; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Authority be granted under the provisions of Decision No. 85189 for PG&E to supply the requested service to Favero Ranch effective March 18, 1977, which constitutes regular statutory notice.
2. The above advice letter and application be marked to show that they were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-2051. The effective date of this resolution is the date hereof.
