SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Acceptance of New Sample Form on Less
Than Statutory Notice to be Used in Conjunction with New Utility Rule

WHEREAS: SAN DIEGO GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 381-G, filed February 24, 1977, having requested Commission approval under Section VB of General Order No. 96-A to file a new sample form on less than statutory notice as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 2356-G to 2358-G, inclusive, and resulting in the following:

- 1. New Sample Form No. 115-4152/1, "Notice of Noncompliance With Rule 14.1, is presented for filing in the utility's filed tariffs.
- 2. This form consists of a two-part notice, an initial notice and a final notice, which will be sent to affected customers in order to inform them that their use of gas includes prohibited use and that their gas service is subject to termination unless they initiate compliance with Rule No. 14.1.
- 3. Rule No. 14.1 was filed by Advice Letter No. 380-G and revised by Advice Letter No. 382-G, in compliance with Decision No. 87017 in Case No. 9642 and became effective on February 28, 1977, as an interim emergency order listing prohibitions and curtailment provisions on natural gas use.
- 4. This sample form has been devised as a means of enforcing the provision of Rule No. 14.1 and will result in more restrictive conditions to some customers by such enforcement of the interim emergency order.
- 5. We find that the urgency of the gas supply situation makes the filing of this new sample form imperative; therefore, good cause appearing.

IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. Authority be granted under Section VB of General Order No. 96-A for SDG&E to place the above tariff sheets into effect on this date, which constitutes less than statutory notice.
- 2. The above tariff sheets be marked to show that they were authorized under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-2056. The effective date of this resolution is the date hereof.
