RESOLUTION

SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Revision of Filed Tariff Rule on Less Than Statutory Notice

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 1054, filed March 8, 1977, requests authority under Sections 491 and 701 of the Public Utilities Code to file a revision to Rule 2, Paragraph (n), as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 14851-G to 14853-G, inclusive, under the following conditions:

1. The proposed revision would add interest at a rate of 7/12% per month, on the average monthly balance, for all balancing account adjustments, whether debit or credit.
2. A similar reference is currently included in the gas and electric cost adjustment clauses of other major utilities, previously authorized by the Commission.
3. This filing will not increase any rate or charge, cause the withdrawal of service nor conflict with other rules or schedules.
4. Authorization on less than statutory notice is requested in order that such accounting may commence at the beginning of the next calendar month; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Authority be granted under Sections 491 and 701 of the Public Utilities Code to place the above tariff sheets into effect on April 1, 1977.
2. The above tariff sheets be marked to show that they were authorized under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-2061. The effective date of this Resolution is the date hereof.
