SUBJECT: Order Rejecting GEDA Increases in Gas Tariff Schedules

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY by Advice Letter No. 1052, filed March 1, 1977 requests authority to increase rates under the GEDA procedures prescribed by Decision No. 81898 dated September 25, 1973 and Decision No. 85849 dated May 18, 1976 as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 14818-G to 14832-G inclusive, to become effective on April 1, 1977.

1. The utility proposes to increase rates by .003¢ per therm, resulting in an annual addition to current revenues of approximately \$235,000, to offset the costs associated with Project No. 76-A approved by Resolution No. G-2033.
2. The GEDA procedures provide for annual rate adjustments that correct for under or over collections experienced during prior periods.
3. It is found reasonable to accumulate the relatively minor 1977 costs associated with Project No. 76-A in the GEDA balancing account; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The 1977 costs be accumulated in the GEDA balancing account and reflected in the next annual GEDA rate adjustment filing.
2. This advice letter filing be rejected and that the above tariff sheets be marked to show that they were rejected by Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-2062. The effective date of this Resolution is the date hereof.
