> SUBJECT: Request to Provide Natural Gas Service In Excess of 50 Mcfd and Under Conditions Deviating from Filed Tariffs

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 1063, filed April 1, 1977, having requested Commission approval under the provisions of Decision No. 85189, to supply additional natural gas in excess of 50 Mcfd to Western Metal Decorating Company (Applicant) in Cucamonga, San Bernardino County under the following circumstances:

1. Applicant's request is for an additional average daily consumption of 524 Mcf, raising his existing average daily consumption from 144 Mcf to 668 Mcf.

2. Applicant will use this additional gas to operate 4 processing ovens and 4 after burners.

3. This increase represents a transfer of existing equipment and load from Applicant's El Monte plant which will be closed, thus offsetting the increase at the new location.

4. The agreement for service deviates from filed tariffs in that the applicant will pay in advance of construction, \$22,698, which is the estimated cost of installation of facilities required to serve this customer, without allowing for one year's estimated revenue to be deducted from the advance.

5. This deviation is necessary because sales to this customer represent sales that would normally go to other customers, thus representing no additional revenue to the utility.

6. We find that this request should be granted and that the Applicant's relocated equipment should continue to be classified in Priority 2A under the enduse criteria adopted in Decision No. 85189; therefore, good casue appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Authority be granted under the provisions of Decision No. 84189 for Southern California Gas Company to supply the requested service to Western Metal Decorating Company effective May 1, 1977.

2. The above advice letter be marked to show that it was authorized under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-2067. The effective date of this resolution is the date hereof.
