> SUBJECT: Request to Provide Additional Natural Gas Service In Excess of 50 Mcfd

WHEREAS: SAN DIEGO GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY, (SDG&E), by Advice Letter No. 386-G, filed April 7, 1977, having requested Commission approval under the provisions of Decision No. 85189, to supply additional natural gas in excess of 50 Mcfd to Burroughs Corp. (Applicant) in San Diego, San Diego County under the following circumstances:

1. Applicant's request is for an additional average daily consumption of 28 Mcf, raising his existing average daily consumption from 52 Mcf to 80 Mcf.

2. Applicant will use this additional gas to operate gas fired boilers at his new semi-conductor research facility.

3. SDG&E proposes to serve this load from a second service connection as the new load is physically remote from the existing service connection.

4. Fuel oil cannot be used since rugged terrain and other presently installed process chemical tanks preclude siting of fuel oil storage tanks.

5. Solar energy cannot be used due to covenants and restrictions against exposed solar panels.

6. We find that this request should be granted and that the Applicant should be classified in Priority 1 under the end-use criteria adopted in Decision No. 85189; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Authority be granted under the provisions of Decision No. 85189 for SDG&E to supply the requested service to Burroughs Corp. effective May 7, 1977.

2. The above advice letter be marked to show that it was authorized under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-2072. The effective date of this resolution is the date hereof.
