> SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Revisions to Tariffs to Prorate Lifeline Space Heating Allowances During Transition Months

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 1065, filed April 4, 1977, having requested Commission approval to file revised tariff schedules dealing with lifeline space heating allowances as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 14904-G to 14917, inclusive, and resulting in the following:

1. At present the full monthly winter lifeline allowance is accorded to bills commencing in April while the summer lifeline allowance is accorded to those bills commencing in October. At the same time, the "space heating only" customers pay a monthly minimum charge for bills commencing in November through April.

2. Lifeline space heating allowances will be prorated during the seasonal transitional months of May and November for computation on bills covering periods spanning from one season to another.

3. The minimum charge for "space heating only" customers will be prorated as of May 1 and November 1 for bills rendered during those months, thus resulting in a technical increase during the month of May.

4. This technical increase will be basically offset by a similar decrease during the month of November, thus resulting in no revenue impact on an annual basis.

5. Also included in this filing is a correction in the Index of Communities Served to place the Community of Yucaipu in Climate Zone 1 rather than Climate Zone 2.

6. We find that this filing is reasonable and should be authorized; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Authority be granted under Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to place the above tariff sheets into effect on May 4, 1977, which constitutes regular statutory notice.

2. The above tariff sheets be marked to show that they were authorized under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-2073. The effective date of this Resolution is the date hereof.
