R E S O L U T I O N

SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Tracking Rate Increase on Less
Than Statutory Notice

WHEREAS: CALIFORNIA-PACIFIC UTILITIES COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 103-G, filed April 14, 1977, having requested authority under the provisions of Decision No. 84006, and under Sections 454 and 491 of the Public Utilities Code, to file revised tariff sheets applicable to its South Tahoe rate area, in order to track a rate increase by its supplier, Southwest Gas Corporation, as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 522-G to 524-G, inclusive, under the following conditions:

1. The proposed revision of 0.684 cents per therm for all nonlifeline rates will result in an annual revenue increase of \$51,980, which will offset the proposed rate increase of Southwest Gas Corp. as submitted in FPC Docket No. RP 77-11.
2. An effective date of May 9, 1977 is requested to coincide with the proposed effective date of Southwest's FPC filing.
3. In the event that the FPC requires Southwest to file different rate schedules or to use a different effective date than anticipated, Cal-Pacific will file substitute tariff sheets to reflect approved rate levels.
4. This proposed rate increase will increase the average residential bill of 100 therms in the Summer, \$0.50 from \$30.16 to \$30.66 and the average Winter bill of 200 therms will increase \$0.23 from \$49.65 to \$49.88.
5. We find this requested rate increase to be reasonable; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Authority be granted under Sections 454, 491 and 701 of the Public Utilities Code, and under the provisions of Decision No. 84006, to place the above tariff sheets or subsequent substitute tariff sheets into effect on May 9, 1977 or on any subsequent date that the FPC requires the Southwest filing to become effective.
2. The above tariff sheets and/or any subsequent substitute tariff sheets be marked to show that they were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-2075. The effective date of this resolution is the date hereof.
