SUBJECT: Request to Provide Natural Gas Service in Excess of 50 Mcfd

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 898-G, filed April 18, 1977, having requested Commission approval under the provisions of Decision No. 85189, to supply natural gas in excess of 50 Mcfd to Certain-Teed Corp. (Applicant) in Chowchilla, Madera County under the following circumstances:

1. Applicant's request is for an average daily consumption of 1,560 Mcfd.
2. Applicant will use this gas to operate 13 high velocity fiberizing burners and 30 manifold forehearth burners in the manufacture of fiberglass insulation.
3. Fuel oil cannot be used in the forehearth or fiberizer due to the diminutive size of the burners and the precise temperature control required.
4. Solar heating equipment is not manufactured for this application.
5. We find that this request should be granted and that the Applicant should be classified in Priority 2A under the end-use criteria adopted in Decision No. 85189; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Authority be granted under the provisions of Decision No. 85189 for PG&E to supply the requested service to Certain-Teed Corp. effective May 18, 1977.
2. The above advice be marked to show that it was authorized by Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-2078. The effective date of this resolution is the date hereof.
