R E S O L U T I O N

SUBJECT: Request for an Extension of Time to Convert to an Alternate Fuel

WHEREAS: PROVIDENCE HOSPITAL (Hospital) in Oakland, Alameda County, by letter dated March 18, 1977, filed March 22, 1977, has requested Commission approval under the provisions of Decision No. 85189 for an extension of time to provide alternate fuel facilities for their boilers under the following circumstances:

1. The Hospital is involved in a major building program.
2. In the process, the 6,000 gallon fuel oil tank has been removed, and will be replaced by a 24,000 gallon system.
3. The new fuel oil system will not be operational until July 31, 1978.
4. The Hospital's priority classification is 2A (temporary) with a peak day load of 200 Mcf.
5. Decision No. 85189 provides that customers who are unable to meet the alternate fuel conversion deadline may apply to the Commission for an extension of time.
6. We find that this request should be granted, and that the Hospital's Priority 2A classification should be extended from December 2, 1977 to July 31, 1978, at which time the Hospital will be reclassified as Priority 3; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Pacific Gas & Electric Company be instructed to extend Providence Hospital's Priority 2A classification from December 2, 1977 to July 31, 1978; at which time they will be reclassified to Priority 3.
2. The effective date of this resolution is the date hereof.
