**SUBJECT:** Request to Provide Natural Gas Service In Excess of 50 Mcfd Under Conditions Deviating From Filed Tariffs

**WHEREAS:** SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 1071, filed May 3, 1977, has requested Commission approval under the provisions of Decision No. 85189, to supply natural gas in excess of 50 Mcfd to Reliable Grease Company (Applicant) in Vernon, Los Angeles County under the following circumstances:

1. Applicant's request is for an average daily consumption of 200 Mcf.
2. Applicant will use this gas to operate two boilers at his new location in Vernon to render animal fat.
3. The relocation to Vernon does not constitute an increase in load to the utility company as the old boilers will be dismantled and service to the old plant site in Los Angeles will be discontinued.
4. The agreement for service deviates from filed tariffs in that the applicant will pay, in advance of construction, \$2,241, which is the estimated cost of the new facilities required to serve this customer.
5. This deviation is necessary because this represents merely the transfer of an existing load and will result in no additional revenue to the utility.
6. We find that this request should be granted and that the Applicant should continue to be classified in Priority 3 under the end-use criteria adopted in Decision No. 85189; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Authority be granted under the provisions of Decision No. 85189 and under Sections 491 and 532 of the Public Utilities Code for Southern California Gas Company to supply the requested service to Reliable Grease Company, effective this date.
2. The above advice letter be marked to show that it was authorized by Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-2082. The effective date of this resolution is the date hereof.
