SUBJECT: Request to Provide Natural Gas Service In Excess of 50 Mcfd

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 1070, filed May 3, 1977, has requested Commission approval under the provisions of Decision No. 85189, to supply natural gas in excess of 50 Mcfd to Taia, Inc. (Applicant) in Santa Ana, Orange County under the following circumstances:

1. Applicant's request is for a peak day consumption of 110 Mcf.
2. Applicant will use this gas to operate equipment in the production of corn and flour tortillas.
3. Applicant states that food equipment manufacturers do not make oil-fired or solar equipment for the production of corn and flour tortillas.
4. The dough used in the production of tortilla type products is very sensitive to the absorption of odors associated with fuel oil combustion.
5. We find that this request should be granted and that the Applicant should be classified in Priority P2A under the end use criteria adopted in Decision No. 85189; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Authority be granted under the provisions of Decision No. 85189 for Southern California Gas Company to supply the requested service to Taia, Inc., effective June 2, 1977,
2. The above advice letter be marked to show that it was authorized by Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-2085. The effective date of this resolution is the date hereof.
