R E S O L U T I O N

SUBJECT: Request to Provide Natural Gas Service In Excess of 50 Mcfd

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 1073, filed May 9, 1977, has requested Commission approval under the provisions of Decision No. 85189, to supply natural gas in excess of 50 Mcfd to Kern County Sheriff's Lerdo Facility (Applicant) north of Bakersfield, Kern County under the following circumstances:

1. Applicant's request is for an average daily consumption of 107 Mcf, with a peak day load of 197 Mcf.
2. Applicant is expanding the Lerdo facility, and the bulk of the heat energy needs of the new section will be met using two fuel oil fired boilers.
3. Some new gas load will be added in the form of cooking facilities and domestic type hot water heaters.
4. The existing facility uses LPG, and Applicant wants to convert this equipment to natural gas.
5. None of the existing LPG equipment or the new gas equipment can use fuel oil.
6. The existing structures are not designed for solar capability, and the "state of the art" regarding solar energy design and availability of equipment is not advanced enough for Applicant's requirements.
7. Service on less than statutory notice is requested because of the late stage of planning and construction of this facility.
8. We find that this request should be granted and that the Applicant should be classified in Priority 2A under the end use criteria adopted in Decision No. 85189; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Authority be granted under the provisions of Decision No. 85189 and under Section 491 of the Public Utilities Code for Southern California Gas Company to supply the requested service to Kern County Sheriff's Lerdo Facility, effective this date.
2. The above advice letter be marked to show that it was approved by Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-2086. The effective date of this resolution is the date hereof.
