WHEREAS: PACIFIC LIGHTING SERVICE COMPANY and SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY by GEDA Project Letter No. 77-B filed May 2, 1977, have requested approval of additional gas exploration and development activities in the Cook Inlet area of south Alaska under the following circumstances:

- 1. Applicant's request is for authority to fund the exploration and development activities of Simasko Production Co. (SIMPCO) in the "Tyonek Prospect".
- 2. Under the agreement with SIMPCO, Pacific Lighting Gas Development (PLGD) is committed to provide funds of \$598,445 representing PLGD's share of the costs incurred by SIMPCO to date. Additionally, PLGD will bear 100% of the cost of drilling and completing two required wells, and, at its option, two lease maintenance wells. PLGD's minimum obligation under the agreement is approximately \$6,000,000 and if it elects to drill the two lease maintenance wells total exploration costs would be approximately \$10,600,000.
- 3. In return for the funds committed PLGD will acquire, until payout, 100% working interest in the wells subject to a 1/6 landowner's royalty and a 1/8 SIMPCO override.
- 4. The resulting 1977 cost of service is estimated at \$67,000 or 0.001¢/therm.
- 5. The Commission has approved seven GEDA projects in the Cook Inlet area. A total of approximately one trillion cubic feet of gas is committed to the south Alaska LNG project. An additional two trillion cubic feet are required to support a 400 MMcfd project.
- 6. We find that the request to participate in the funding of the above project should be granted and that a public hearing is not necessary, therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. Authority be granted pursuant to the provisions of Decisions Nos. 81898 and 81837 for Pacific Lighting Service Company and Southern California Gas Company to participate in funding the above project.
- 2. The 1977 cost of service associated with the funding of the project shall be accumulated and reflected in the next annual adjustment for under or over collections.
- 3. The Project Letter be marked to show that it was accepted for filing under Resoltution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-2088. The effective date of this Resolution is the date hereof.
