- 2. The filing of these reports were required at a time when the cost of service was considered a major factor in rate making procedure.
- 3. The utility believes that a change in rate design philosophy has occurred which indicates that this is no longer the case.
- 4. The compilation of data and the preparation of such annual reports entails extensive administrative efforts on the part of the utility.
 - 5. We find that this request is reasonable; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Authority be granted under Section 1708 of the Public Utilities Code for PG&E to discontinue the reporting requirements of the above Commission Resolutions or Decisions, effective June 2, 1977, which constitutes regular statutory notice. The effective date of this Resolution is the date hereof.
