SUBJECT: Order Rescinding Prior Commission Order

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 900-G, filed May 3, 1977, having requested authority to discontinue reporting requirements associated with gas main extensions as previously ordered by prior Commission Orders as follows:

1. The filing of annual rate of return reports were required for the following gas main extensions by the indicated Commission Resolutions or Decisions:

2. The filing of these reports were required at a time when the cost of service was considered a major factor in rate making procedure.

3. The utility believes that a change in rate design philosophy has occurred which indicates that this is no longer the case.

4. The compilation of data and the preparation of such annual reports entails extensive administrative efforts on the part of the utility.

5. We find that this request is reasonable; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Authority be granted under Section 1708 of the Public Utilities Code for PG&E to discontinue the reporting requirements of the above Commission Resolutions or Decisions, effective June 2, 1977, which constitutes regular statutory notice. The effective date of this Resolution is the date hereof.
