SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Acceptance of Special Contract Under
Conditions Deviating From Filed Tariffs

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 904-G, filed
May 10, 1977, having requested authorization to carry out the terms and conditions
of a special contract with Toltec Foods, Inc., (Applicant) covering a gas main
extension and supply of natural gas to applicant's facilities in Richmond, Contra
Costa County, under conditions deviating from filed tariffs, and resulting in the
following:

- 1. The agreement deviates from filed tariffs in that the Applicant will
pay, in advance of construction, \$700.74, which is the estimated total cost of the
extension facilities.
2. The agreement further deviates from filed tariffs in that the Applicant
is required to pay a cost-of-ownership fund of \$344.77, which is the present worth
of annual charges of 12% per annum for five years.
3. Refunds will be made in accordance with the provisions of Rule No. 15
for residential customers and only if Applicant is willing to accept a permanent
reduction in the hourly rate of flow for nonresidential customers.
4. Prior approval to provide gas in excess of 50 Mcfd was granted to this
Applicant by Commission Resolution No. G-1952 on September 14, 1976.
5. We find that this agreement is compensatory and nondiscriminatory and
provides for service to the Applicant in such a manner as to not place a burden on
other ratepayers; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. Authority be granted under Sections 454 and 532 of the Public Utilities
Code to place this contract into effect on June 9, 1977.
2. The above advice letter and contract be marked to show that they were
accepted for filing under Resolution of the State of California No. G-2091. The
effective date of this Resolution is the date hereof.
