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SUBJECT: Request to Provide Natural Gas Service in Excess of 50 Mcfd

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 910-G, filed May 24, 1977, has requested Commission approval under the provisions of Decision No. 85189, to supply additional natural gas in excess of 50 Mcfd to Marge Robinson (Applicant) in Gridley, Butte County, under the following circumstances:

- 1. Applicant's request is for an additional daily consumption of 46 Mcf, raising the existing average daily consumption from 93 Mcf to 139 Mcf.
- 2. Applicant will use this additional gas to operate two direct process prune dehydrators on a seasonal basis principally in the month of August.
- 3. Fuel oil cannot be used in direct-firing of burners as the potential of odor and/or tast contamination of the fruit cannot be tolerated.
  - 4. There is no solar dehydrator available at the present time.
- 5. Approval on less than statutory notice is requested in order that construction may be started on a timely basis in order to have the facilities operational in time for the drying season.
- 6. We find that this request should be granted and that the Applicant should be classified in Priority 2-A under the end-use criteria adopted in Decision No. 85189; therefore, good cause appearing,

## IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. Authority be granted under Section 491 of the Public Utilities Code and under the provisions of Decision No. 85189 for PG&E to supply the requested service to Marge Robinson effective this date.
- 2. The above advice letter and contract be marked to show that they were accepted for filing under Resolution of the State of California No. G-2094. The effective date of this Resolution is the date hereof.
