SUBJECT: Request to Provide Natural Gas Service in Excess of 50 Mcfd

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 902-G, filed May 10, 1977, has requested Commission approval under the provisions of Decision No. 85189, to supply natural gas in excess of 50 Mcfd to Sunsweet Dryers (Applicant) in Hamilton City, Glenn County under the following circumstances:

1. Applicant's request is for an average daily consumption of 1,080 Mcf.
2. Applicant will use this additional gas to operate 18 burners for 36 prune dehydrator tunnels.
3. Fuel oil cannot be used in this operation due to the danger of product contamination by combustion residues.
4. Solar energy cannot be used for this operation since technology has not progressed to the point of commercial feasibility.
5. We find that this request should be granted and that the Applicant should be classified in Priority 2A under the end-use criteria adopted in Decision No. 85189; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Authority be granted under the provisions of Decision No. 85189 for Pacific Gas & Electric Company to supply the requested service to Sunsweet Dryers effective this date.
2. The above advice letter and application be marked to show that they were accepted for filing under Resolution of the State of California No. G-2107. The effective date of this Resolution is the date hereof.
