SUBJECT: Request to Provide Additional Natural Gas Service in Excess of 50 Mcfd

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 903-G, filed May 10, 1977, has requested Commission approval under the provisions of Decision No. 85189, to supply additional natural gas in excess of 50 Mcfd to J. G. Brattan Company (Applicant) in Ord Bend, Glenn County under the following circumstances:

1. Applicant's request is for an additional average daily consumption of 390 Mcf, raising his existing average daily consumption from 549 Mcf to 939 Mcf.
2. Applicant will use this additional gas to operate 10 direct fired burners for 18 prune dehydrator tunnels.
3. Fuel oil cannot be used in this operation due to the danger of product contamination by combustion residues.
4. Solar energy cannot be used for this operation since technology has not progressed to the point of commercial feasibility.
5. We find that this request should be granted and that the Applicant should be classified in Priority 2A under the end-use criteria adopted in Decision No. 85189; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Authority be granted under the provisions of Decision No. 85189 for PG&E to supply the requested service to J. G. Brattan Company effective this date.
2. The above advice letter and application be marked to show that they were accepted for filing under Resolution of the State of California No. G-2108. The effective date of this Resolution is the date hereof.
