SUBJECT: Request to Provide Additional Natural Gas Service in Excess of 50 Mcfd

WHEREAS: SAN DIEGO GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 391-G, filed June 16, 1977, has requested Commission approval under the provisions of Decision No. 85189, to supply additional natural gas in excess of 50 Mcfd to Kyocera International (Applicant) in San Diego, San Diego County under the following circumstances:

1. Applicant's request is for an additional average daily consumption of 50 Mcf, raising his existing average daily consumption from 1 Mcf to 51 Mcf.
2. Applicant will use this additional gas to operate a new gas fired kiln used in the manufacture of ceramic packaging for electronic micro-circuits.
3. Fuel oil cannot be used in this direct fired process since combustion residue of sulfates would prevent the deposition of precious metals on the ceramic product.
4. The use of solar energy is not feasible due to the high (1,500°C) temperatures required for the production process.
5. We find that this request should be granted and that the Applicant should be classified in Priority 1 under the end-use criteria adopted in Decision No. 85189; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Authority be granted under the provisions of Decision No. 85189 for San Diego Gas & Electric Company to supply the requested service to Kyocera International effective July 16, 1977.
2. The above advice letter and application be marked to show that they were accepted for filing under Resolution of the State of California No. G-2109. The effective date of this Resolution is the date hereof.
