SUBJECT: Request to Provide Natural Gas Service in Excess of 50 Mcfd

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 907-G, filed May 20, 1977, has requested Commission approval under the provisions of Decision No. 85189, to supply natural gas in excess of 50 Mcfd to San Francisco Municipal Railway (Applicant) in San Francisco, San Francisco County under the following circumstances:

1. Applicant's request is for a peak day consumption of 76 Mcf.
2. Applicant will use this gas to operate 36 space heaters, 1 high pressure washer and 1 heat treating furnace at their new Muni Metro Rail Center and shop.
3. When this 120,000 square foot facility was designed, there were no limitations on gas service to utility customers; and when construction started, Commission approval was not required by a utility company to serve a nonresidential customer whose demand was under 200 Mcf per day (Decision No. 83819).
4. All gas equipment is installed, and changing to an oil fired system would be unreasonable, extremely costly, and would significantly delay the use of this vital municipal railway maintenance facility.
5. We find that this request should be granted and that the Applicant should be classified in Priority 1 under the end-use criteria adopted in Decision No. 85189; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Authority be granted under the provisions of Decision No. 85189 for PG&E to supply the requested service to San Francisco Municipal Railway effective this date.
2. The above advice letter and application be marked to show that they were accepted for filing under Resolution of the State of California No. G-2111. The effective date of this Resolution is the date hereof.
