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SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Acceptance of Special Contract Under Conditions Deviating from Filed Tariffs

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 922-G, filed June 21, 1977, having requested authorization to carry out the terms and conditions of a special contract with the City of Santa Clara (Applicant) covering a gas main extension to provide service of natural gas to applicant's facilities at Mariott Commercial Park Improvement Project, under conditions deviating from filed tariffs, and resulting in the following:

- 1. The agreement deviates from filed tariffs in that the Applicant will pay in advance of construction, \$19,165, which is the cost of the facilities less a credit for trenching and backfilling to be done by Applicant.
- 2. The agreement further deviates from filed tariffs in that the Applicant is required to pay a cost-of-ownership fund of \$9,429, which is the present worth of annual charges of 12% per annum for five years.
- 3. We find that this agreement is compensatory and nondiscriminatory and provides for service to the Applicant in such a manner as to not place a burden on other ratepayers; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. Authority be granted under Section XB of General Order No. 96-A and under Sections 454 and 532 of the Public Utilities Code to place this contract into effect on July 21, 1977.
- 2. The above advice letter and contract be marked to show that they were accepted for filing under Resolution of the State of California No. G-2115. The effective date of this Resolution is the date hereof.
