SUBJECT: Request to Provide Natural Gas Service In Excess of 50 Mcfd

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 920-G, filed June 21, 1977, has requested Commission approval under the provisions of Decision No. 85189, to supply natural gas in excess of 50 Mcfd to Zaven J. Shabazian (Applicant) in Fresno, Fresno County under the following circumstances:

1. Applicant's request is for an average daily consumption of 890 Mcf.
2. Applicant will use this gas to operate 8 direct fired, fruit drying tunnels.
3. Fuel oil cannot be used in these direct fired fruit dryers without product contamination.
4. Tunnels designed to use solar energy for fruit drying are not commercially available at present.
5. Applicant meets the criteria for FPC Priority 2 classification (Docket No. RP 72-6).
6. We find that this request should be granted and that the Applicant should be classified in Priority 2A under the end use criteria adopted in Decision No. 85189; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Authority be granted under the provisions of Decision No. 85189 for Pacific Gas & Electric Company to supply the requested service to Zaven J. Shabazian effective July 21, 1977.
2. The above advice letter and application be marked to show that they were accepted for filing under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-2118. The effective date of this resolution is the date hereof.
