SUBJECT: Request to Provide Natural Gas Service In Excess of 50 Mcfd

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 1086, filed July 8, 1977, has requested Commission approval under the provisions of Decision No. 85189, to supply natural gas in excess of 50 Mcfd to Kern County Sheriff's Lerdo Facility (Applicant) north of Bakersfield, Kern County under the following circumstances:

- 1. Applicant's request is for an average daily consumption of 107 Mcf, with a peak day load of 197 Mcf.
- 2. Applicant will use this gas to operate new domestic type, direct fired equipment for space and water heating; and to operate existing LPG fired kitchen and laundry equipment.
 - The load is scattered throughout the complex in numerous buildings.
- 4. Use of fuel oil is not feasible in the domestic type equipment involved, and the existing LPG fired laundry and kitchen equipment cannot be converted to fuel oil.
- The design of solar energy equipment and its availability in the marketplace have not yet advanced sufficiently to meet Applicant's needs.
- Applicant meets the criteria for FPC Priority 2 classification (Docket No. RP 72-6).
- 7. We find that this request should be granted and that the Applicant should be classified in Priority 2A under the end use criteria adopted in Decision No. 85189; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. Authority be granted under Section 491 of the Public Utilities Code and under the provisions of Decision No. 85189 for Southern California Gas Company to supply the requested service to Kern County Sheriff's Lerdo facility effective this date.
- The above advice letter be marked to show that it was accepted for filing under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-2121.
